# **News Digest**

The News Digest is an electronic media clipping service compiled and distributed each weekday with environmental news stories from media outlets throughout the state.

# **Weekly Alert**

The Weekly Alert includes action alerts, events, resources, and announcements from within the community, as well as updates on regulatory boards and commissions. Posting to the Weekly Alert allows an affiliate organization to share information within the entire affiliate network.

# Legislative Update

The Legislative Update is a weekly email while the NC General Assembly is in session which provides comprehensive updates, analysis, and insights into environmental issues being considered.

### **Tools and Resources**

We provide our affiliates with a great collection of tools, resources, and training opportunities.

### **Skills Training**

We provide training opportunities throughout the year on topics including advocacy, organizing, fundraising, and more.

# **Events Listing**


We post upcoming events from affiliate organizations on our Events page.

# Calculating your dues

Dues are calculated from the following sliding scale based on annual operating expenses. National environmental organizations with only a field staff presence in North Carolina should calculate dues based on their state budget, with a minimum of \$100.

Annual Expenses	Dues
Below \$1,000	\$25
\$1,000 - \$9,999	\$50
\$10,000 - \$49,999	\$100
\$50,000 - \$74,999	\$250
\$75,000 - \$99,999	\$400
\$100,000 - \$149,999	\$650
\$150,000 - \$199,999	\$850
\$200,000 - \$249,999	\$1,000
\$250,000 - \$299,999	\$1,250
\$300,000 - \$499,999	\$1,500
\$500,000 - \$749,999	\$2,000
\$750,000 and above	\$2,500
